THE *EX PARTE* APPLICATION of the Respondent/Applicant, PHILLIP RICHARD PARADIS, coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on February 24, 1997, and on hearing Diane M. Bell, counsel for the Respondent/Application, and on reading the material filed:

THIS COURT ORDERS THAT the Petitioner, YUKIKO IWAUCHI, born March 2, 1963 is prohibited from removing the infant child of the marriage, namely, RYOJU ANTOINE IWAUCHI-PARADIS, born August 7, 1993 (Age 3 1/2) from the jurisdiction of this Court without either the consent of the Respondent/Applicant, PHILLIP RICHARD PARADIS, in writing, or further order of this Honourable Court.


THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT the Petitioner, YUKIKO IWAUCHI, shall deliver forthwith to her solicitor, Jeremy Sheppard, any and all passports and/or travel

documents the Petitioner has issued in her name or the name of the child of the marriage, namely, RYOJU ANTOINE IWAUCHI-PARADIS, born August 7, 1993 (Age 3 1/2), for safekeeping until agreement between the parties in writing or further order of this Honourable Court.


THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT any peace officer having jurisdiction in the Province of British Columbia, who on reasonable and probable grounds believes that the Petitioner, YUKIKO IWAUCHI, born March 2, 1963, is in breach of the terms of this Order prohibiting the removal of the parties' infant child from the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court, shall immediately arrest the Petitioner and bring her before this court on the next day following the arrest to be dealt with on an inquiry to determine whether she has committed a breach of the order or is in contempt of the court.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS THAT the Petitioner, YUKIKO IWAUCHI, is at liberty, upon 2 clear days notice to the Respondent/Applicant, PHILLIP RICHARD PARADIS, to apply to set aside and/or vary this Order.

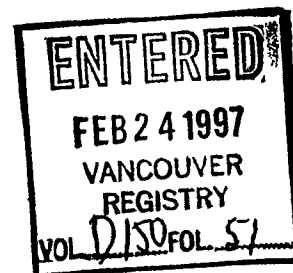
